We are looking for people to...

Provide appropriate support to young people with special educational needs (SEN) and their parents/carers through the transition from a traditional Special Educational Needs Statement system to the new Education, Health & Care (EHC) assessment and planning process.

- Full training will be provided
- Volunteers will be working either alongside other volunteers and staff or independently
- Working hours are flexible
- Volunteers would usually need to commit to around 6 hours per month
- To support group-based and individually focused support, workshops/events which will empower young people and parents/carers to make informed choices/decisions

Successful applicants will be required to complete two days of face to face training, two days on-line training plus some supplementary training.

Training is available throughout Essex.
